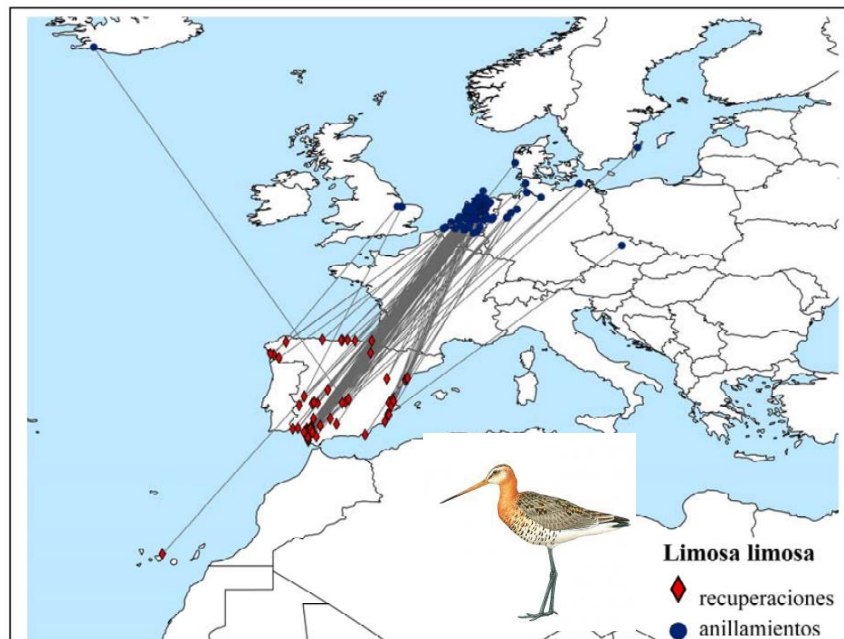
Spain started to be involved in AMBI since April 2016 attending the Texel (Netherlands) meeting.

Previous to be involved in AMBI, Spain did some works in the Bijagos Archipelago in 2008 related to environmental issues:

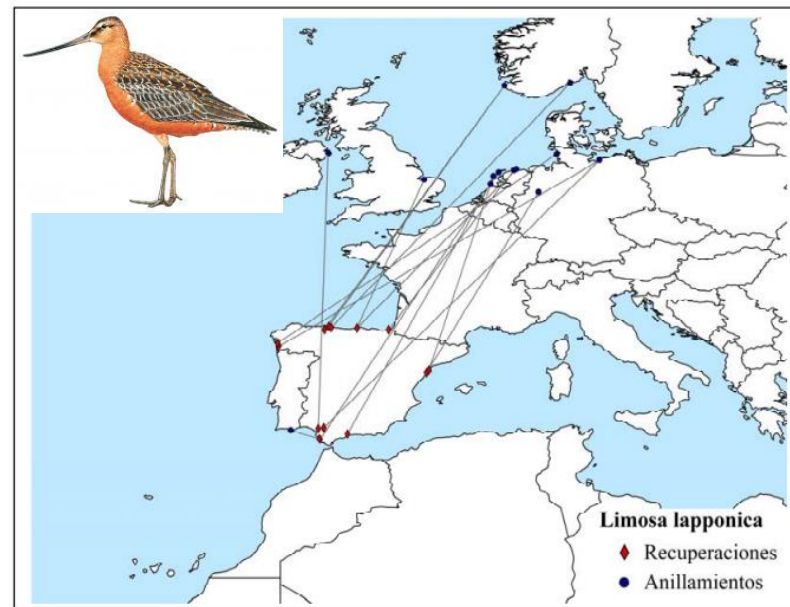

- Outreach



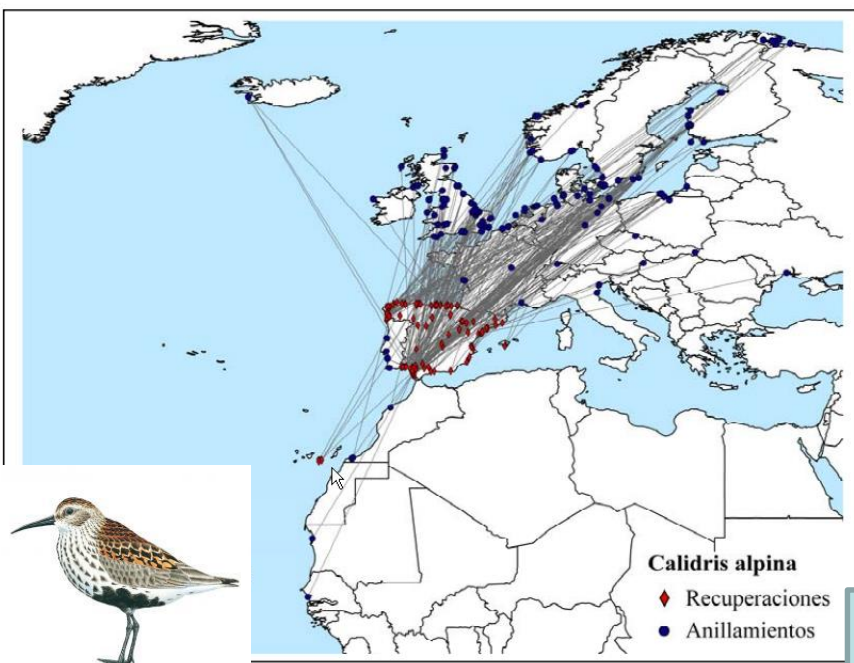
Nº de aves anilladas por país recuperadas en España



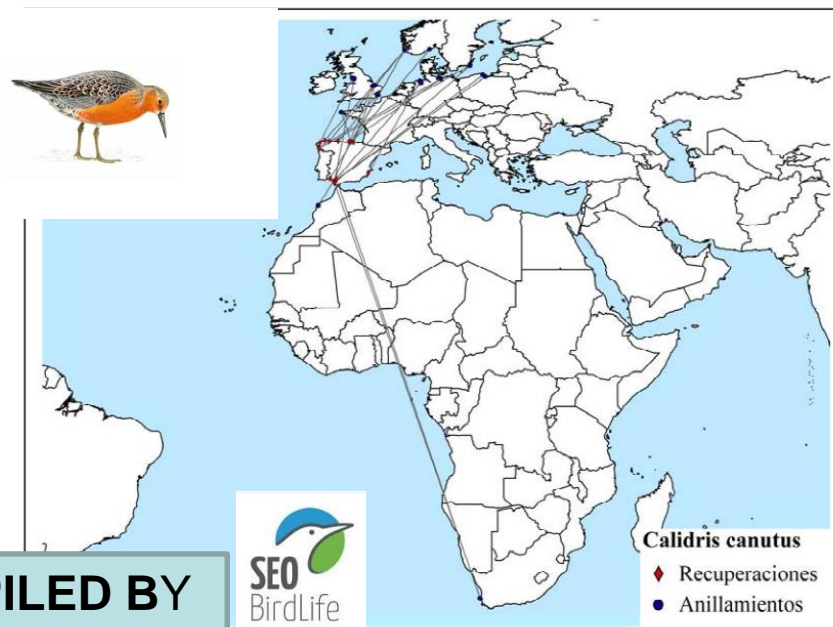
